- II. Michael Arcibeque, STRCC Chairperson presented an overview of the December 12th STRCC and STREOC Joint Meeting.
 - a. On December 12, 2003 the STRCC Strategic Plan was approved and the Electronic Citation Pilot Plan was approved.

- b. The detailed meeting notes for December 12th are attached.
- III. Data Sharing Initiatives
- a. The new Ignition Interlock legislature was discussed. Mike Sandavol reviewed the bill and explained the need for a system of ignition interlock data collection and reporting.
 - 1. The STRCC Staff are evaluating solutions
 - 2. The courts, MVD, probation, law enforcement, NMSH&TD, and UNM - DGR have been identified as possible users of the interlock data
 - b. Electronic Abstract Submission
 - 1. Metro Court is now sending abstract/disposition information electronically to MVD.
 - 2. It was agreed that MVD and AOC would work together to provide the electronic transmission of all Magistrate Court abstract information to MVD.
- IV. The new MVD, "DRIVE INSURED" program is in operation. Curt Sanchez urged every one to check that their physical vehicle VIN numbers match the VIN numbers appearing on their vehicle registration and insurance cards. Any small discrepancies will trigger a letter from MVD stating that your vehicle is not insured.
- a. Please call 1-866-891-0665 to check how a particular vehicle is listed in the insurance database.
 - b. In addition visit <http://www.driveinsured.com/>. Please pass this information along to family, friends, and coworkers to avoid any problems.
- V. As outlines in the STRCCC Strategic Plan, a STRCC website is to be designed to facilitate the sharing of information. The planning for the site will begin and reports will be made to the STRCC for their input and approval. The site will be developed by STRCC Staff.
- VI. The Electronic Citation Pilot (TraCS evaluation) was reviewed and discussed.

- a. The TraCS User Agreement needs to be signed. This will allow us to use the Software Development Kit (SDK) to create forms that meet specific New Mexico standards.
- b. A special committee will be formed to plan and implement the pilot. The committee will be made up of Managers, Technical, and End User groups.
